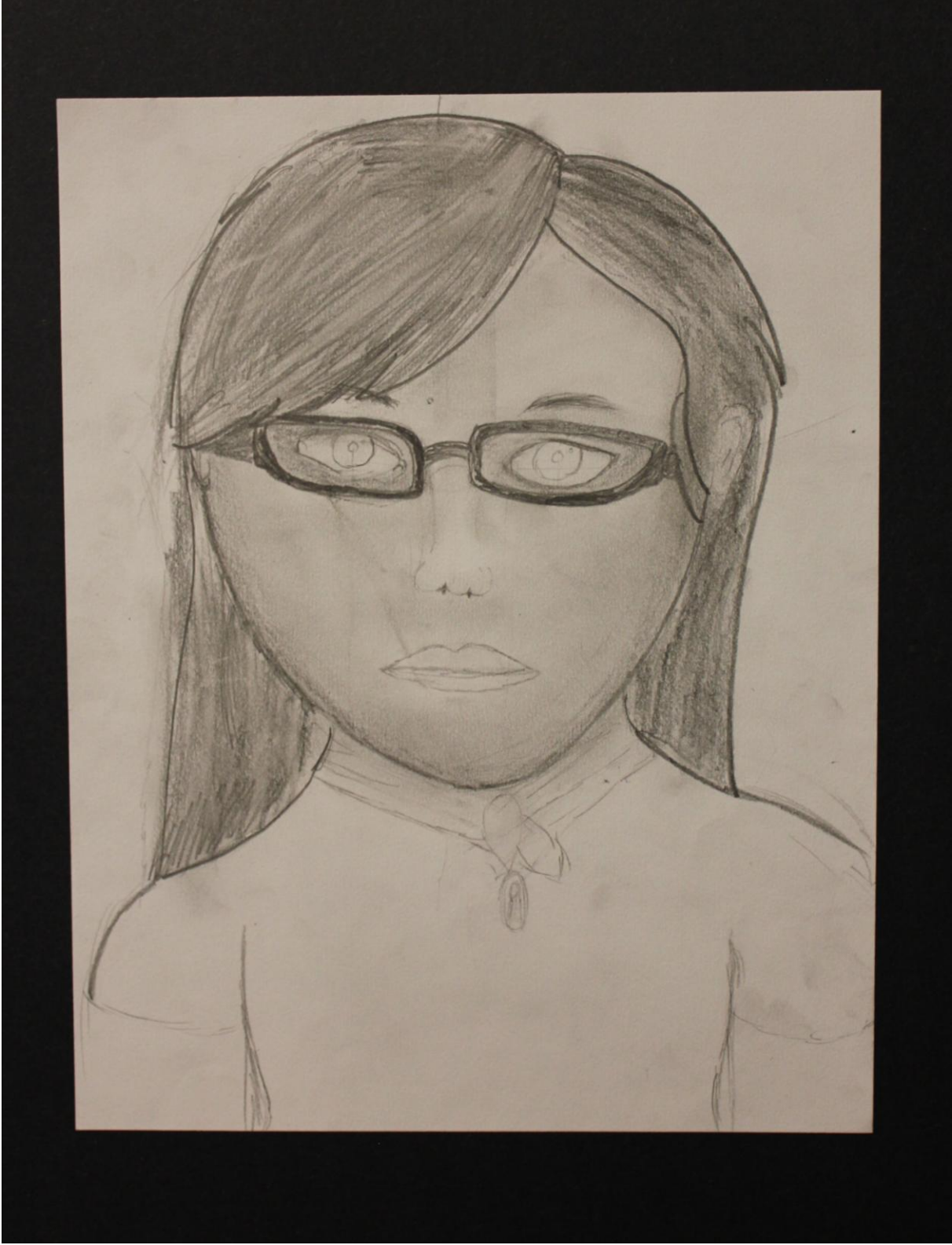
Reason(s) for the nomination
